

Lake Carroll Reverse911 T-E-X-T-I-N-G

"This is the Lake Carroll Association with an important message for you."

All registered Reverse911 participants received a voice message call regarding a new option available through our Reverse911 service (sent on Wednesday, March 18th). The message was as follows:

"This call is regarding the Lake Carroll Reverse 911 Services that you currently subscribe to. You now have a choice to receive these important messages in the form of a text message or continue to receive the recorded messages as a phone call. Due to the size restraints (160 characters), the text will be a condensed version of the recorded message.

If you would like to receive text message notifications, text the word ALERT to 22300. Again, to receive text message notifications, text the word ALERT, that's A, L, E, R, T, to 22300.

Once you opt-in for text messaging you will no longer receive voice messages on that cell phone line. By opting in, you are requesting to receive text messages instead of voice messages. Landlines will continue to receive voice messages.

At any time, you may choose to Opt-out of text messaging by texting the word **Stop** to **22300** from your cell phone. Text messages will be disabled to the cell number the message was received from and your voice phone calls will be reestablished on that specific cell phone line. (You can opt-in again at any time by texting **Alert** to **22300**.)
