Do you have outdoor lighting that could be unknowingly offensive to your neighbors?

We have received numerous complaints of neighbors' lighting interfering with members' enjoyment of the nighttime views.

Lake Carroll's "Good Neighbor Outdoor Lighting" policy provides various lighting options that should be considered when adding lights for security, as well as to enhance your landscape. All lighting must be installed to not be offensive to neighbors or obstruct the view of cars on the roads or blind vision of boats on the lake.

Please take a moment to look at your existing outside lighting to ensure it benefits your residence without impeding on your neighbors...next door, up or down the hill, across the street, or across the lake. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
