Lake Carroll Fishing Regulations

Refer to the Lake Carroll Rules & Regulations Title V Chapter 54.02 and 54.03 for the complete Fishing Regulations. (In booklet page 39)



- People 16 years and over must have a valid state of Illinois fishing license.
- Fishing is prohibited in rearing ponds and all waters below the dam.
- Any guest fishing Lake Carroll must be accompanied by a LCA Member unless they are a family member with a family member fishing pass, available at the Association Office.
- No fish cleaning in the Pavilions. Violators subject to a fine.
- Boat live wells, bilge areas, hulls and trailers should be inspected and cleaned to prevent the spread of invasive species such as Zebra Mussels and Eurasian Milfoil, before launching in Lake Carroll.
